

 You can log in once you have been nominated by your home institution.


## Deadlines

 Deadlines for Fall (Sept to Dec), Full Year (Sept to Apr) & Winter (Jan to Apr) applicants to submit completed applications:

• Graduate Studies: March 1, 2017

• Undergraduate Studies: April 1, 2017

Note: We do not have a separate deadline for winter.



## Instructions Step 4 Continued




- 1. Complete all the pages of the application.

#### Declaration by Applicant

- I declare that I have read the above application, have a good comprehension of the requirements indicated, and that to the best of my knowledge the information supplied is correct and complete.
- I recognize that it is my responsibility to provide all necessary documentary evidence of my qualifications, studies, and experience and hereby authorize U of T to obtain further information where necessary.
- 3. I agree to present the original copies of my academic results and transcripts for verification by U of T.
- The University of Toronto reserves the right to withdraw any offer to me or cease my enrollment at any stage during my course of study where false or misleading information has been provided.
- 5. I understand that I will be admitted as a non-degree student to the University of Toronto.
- I understand that the University of Toronto cannot guarantee that any or all courses required for my academic
  program will be offered during the period of my exchange, and that individual faculties and departments at the
  University of Toronto have the right to refuse access to courses to exchange students.
- 7. I accept the condition that with my admittance to the University of Toronto and not being a Canadian citizen or Permanent Residence, I must enrol in the University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) and am responsible for paying either prior to or immediately upon my arrival.
- 8. For Canadian citizens and Permanent Residence ONLY: I recognize that if I am coming back from an absence outside of Canada, I am required to apply for UHIP until the Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) becomes effective
- I agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the University of Toronto, including but not limited to Code of Student Behaviour and Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.
- I agree that the Student Exchange Office can share information regarding academic and non-academic behavior with your home institution. This includes transcripts, academic and health issues.







- Please Note: Your application will be considered incomplete until all required documents have been submitted by you and your home institution by the deadline indicated on the first page.
- Admission Timeline: Completed applications will be reviewed between April-June. Admission packages will be electronically sent out to your institutional email address in May-June. Incomplete applications will take longer to review. No paper documents will be mailed to admitted students. If you are admitted, you will receive an email in June-July with full details and information about course selection.
